- IFCJ Canada reaches tens of thousands of people each year, mobilizing a national network of supporters to stand with the Jewish people and lift Israel in prayer.

Flags of Fellowship is an annual event that remembers the October 7, 2023 attacks and honours the victims. It is also a growing movement that brings together Christians from around the world who, through their faith and compassion, stand in solidarity with the Jewish people in Israel and around the world.

In 2025, more than 1,300 organizations—including many synagogues—joined together for Flags of Fellowship. This collaboration became a visible expression of hope and solidarity, helping to build bridges within communities and foster lasting connections. Together, participants planted over 1.5 million Israeli flags—a meaningful gesture of unity, remembrance, and support for the Jewish people.

This movement continues to inspire and strengthen relationships, sending a message of fellowship and compassion that extends far beyond the event itself.
